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WECHAT IN EDUCATION AND RESULT FROM ITS USE

This research paper explores the use of WeChat in education and describes the results of previous research in this area. The article also discusses the positive and negative aspects of using WeChat in education and offers recommendations for further research and use of the platform in education. The findings of the study show that WeChat can be a useful tool in education, but requires a deeper understanding and safety and efficiency in use. WeChat is a messenger developed by Tencent that includes text and voice messaging, video calls, payments, games, and more.

Today WeChat occupies the following positions:

- 1) WeChat user base exceeds 1.2 billion users worldwide;
- 2) more than 900 million users use WeChat daily;

- 3) 61 % of WeChat users are in China, the remaining 39 % are distributed in other countries;
- 4) In China, WeChat is one of the most popular instant messengers used for communication, shopping and other tasks.

In China, along with WeChat, other communication platforms are used in education, some of which are listed below:

DingTalk is a free communication platform developed by Alibaba. It is used in schools and universities for communication between students, faculty and administration, for managing learning materials, and for delivering online courses.

Tencent Classroom is an online platform developed by Tencent. It is used in schools and universities to conduct online courses, organize webinars and communicate between students and teachers.

Alibaba Cloud Classroom is a cloud education platform developed by Alibaba. It is used in schools and universities to organize online courses, manage learning materials, and communicate between students and teachers.

Zoom is a popular video conferencing platform that is also used in education in China for online lessons and webinars.

Lark is a free communication platform developed by ByteDance. It is used in schools and universities to organize communication between students and teachers, manage educational materials and conduct online courses.

In China, WeChat is of particular importance as it is the main means of communication between people. Most Chinese people use it to communicate with friends, colleagues and business partners, as well as to pay for goods and services, order a taxi and much more.

Creating WeChat bots to automatically process student requests:

Using WeChat Pay to pay for educational services:

WeChat Pay is a payment system that allows WeChat users to make in-app payments. Educational institutions can use WeChat Pay to pay for educational services, such as paying for study materials or online courses.

Using WeChat to Organize Virtual Events:

WeChat can be used to organize virtual events such as webinars, online conferences or remote lectures. This will allow students and teachers from different regions to interact with each other and share knowledge without leaving home.
