PROTECTION OF HUMAN RIGHTS AND FREEDOMS IN THE CRIMINAL PROCEDURE OF REPUBLIC OF BELARUS

Key words: criminal procedure, human rights, human freedoms, protection, restriction of human rights, procedural guarantees, justice control, public prosecutor's supervision, indemnification, discharge.

The object of the Thesis is public relations arising in criminal procedure connected to restoration of broken human rights and freedoms.

The subject of the research is essence, aim, ensuring of protection of human rights and freedoms, requirements of legitimacy of measures of restriction of human rights and freedoms, conditions and the order of indemnification of damage caused by illegal actions of criminal enforcement agency.

The purpose of the research is to build up a theoretical bases of protection of human rights and freedoms in the criminal procedure as well as to advise the improvement of the activities of court and criminal prosecutors guaranteed this protection.

The methodological basis of the Thesis consists of general and specific ways of cognition. The study uses system, analysis and synthesis, generalization, induction and deduction, historical, logical, comparative-and-legal, sociological methods.

Theoretical bases of the complex of legal phenomenon of the protection of human rights and freedoms in criminal procedure of Republic of Belarus is studied for the first time in the Thesis. The study secures further development of legal coordination of exact aspects of protection, new criminal procedure legislation applied in accordance with international legislation requirements. The study has developed new initiations for improvements of norms regulated through guarantees of protection of human rights and freedoms by activities of court and criminal prosecutors in criminal procedure of Republic of Belarus.

The output of the Thesis could be exercised by activities of court and criminal prosecutors, academic process, as well as be used in improvement of the criminal procedure legislation.
