## ABSTRACT

The purpose of the study is to identify trends in the development of buddhistic communities in RuNet.

The object of the study is Buddhist communities in the Russian-speaking cultural space.

The subject of the research is the features of virtual Buddhist communities in RuNet.

The methodological basis of the Master's thesis consists of the general-scientific methods of scientific cognition: the method of analysis and synthesis, the method of induction and deduction, the descriptive and historical method, the method of classification, the method of analogy and generalization.

In the process of preparing the thesis the following results were obtained:

- considered Buddhism as a religious-philosophical phenomenon and part of the cultural tradition of the Russian-speaking cultural space;
- identified trends in the development of Buddhism in the context of globalization;
- an excursion into the history of the development of Buddhism in the Russian-speaking cultural space;
- revealed the characteristics of Buddhist Internet resources in RuNet.
