

SOME FEATURES OF TEACHING FOREIGN LANGUAGE WITH DISTANCE LEARNING

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Abstract: the article considers the most modern and popular form of foreign language teaching – distance learning; there was given a brief description and definition of distance learning, its positive and negative aspects and some approaches to teaching a foreign language using this form of training.

We live in an era of high technology and modern technical capabilities. These realities require a review of the education process, because many of the learning technologies that were used some time ago are not effective enough today or do not correspond to the new trends of the time. The teacher should take into account and actively use modern technical capabilities in their activities.

Modern information technologies help students extract information from various sources, which in turn can be a platform for forming their own point of view, as well as help in the ability to defend it, make the necessary arguments, and apply the knowledge gained in practice.

The so-called distance learning is becoming increasingly popular. This form can complement all known traditional forms of distance learning (full-time, part-time). Thanks to this type of training, students have the opportunity to gain new knowledge, master the material, attend lectures, seminars and practical classes without leaving home, using only their home computer. Despite the fact, that such specially trained people as system administrators, programmers, and administrators of educational programs are involved in remote work, the leading

role is still assigned to the teacher. The main principle of "distance" is also a direct interactive interaction between the teacher and the student. It should be noted that distance learning does not replace, but effectively complements the traditional education system, making it possible to teach what the student needs, when and where it is convenient for him. In other words, distance learning is aimed at organizing productive independent, educational and cognitive activities of the student.

Learning foreign languages through distance education is not a new type of education. Today, there are a huge number of educational platforms that allow you to learn foreign languages, independently planning the appropriate place and time of the lesson. In distance learning, an individual approach is successfully implemented, which takes into account the capabilities of students, their intellectual abilities, and overcomes psychological barriers in the development of educational material. The use of distance learning and the online environment allows students to foreign language through communication with native speakers, as there is the opportunity to communicate in various chat rooms and social networks where you can train not only speaking, but also grammar. When using this type of training, the teacher is given the opportunity to use all advanced technical training tools, such as video materials, presentations, electronic training programs and dictionaries, computer graphics, video conferences, and so on.

Summing up all the above, I would like to highlight the main advantages of distance learning in foreign languages. Firstly, it is freedom and flexibility in choosing the place and time, as well as the duration of classes, secondly, it reduces the cost of purchasing methodological literature, and thirdly, it is an opportunity for both technical and intellectual modern education.

Along with the positive aspects of this type of education, it is necessary to highlight the disadvantages. The main thing is that despite modern accessibility, not everyone has the opportunity to use a computer and other technologies, not everyone has a computer and Internet access. However, I want to believe that soon

this will not be a problem. The second important point is self-discipline, self-organization and willpower, because not everyone is able to quickly "get involved" in the process. It is also necessary to note the issue of price, because not all of us are able to pay for training online, moreover, training with a native speaker, classes with which are much higher than with a regular teacher.

In conclusion, we can conclude that learning foreign languages and organizing the process remotely is a modern and popular way of both teaching and learning, which is the best way to realize personal development. – oriented and individual approaches to education, in which the center always remains the student's personality, ready for continuous education and improvement of their intellectual, linguistic and technical abilities, because it is the continuity of the language education process that is the key to successful foreign language acquisition. However, when choosing between the traditional form of teaching a foreign language and this type, it is necessary to clearly distinguish and understand all the advantages and disadvantages of "distance".

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
