ABSTRACT

The object of research of the thesis is the generation in the modern Belarusian society. The subject of the research of the thesis is the communication of generations in the second half of the XX century, the first half of the XI century. The purpose of the thesis is to reveal the features of communication between generations in modern Belarusian society. The methodological basis of the thesis was the method of in-depth interview.

In the process of writing the thesis, the following results were obtained: the concept of "generation" as a social problem was considered; the features of communication between representatives of different generations were identified; the digital space was characterized as a communication problem; the theory of generations and its interpretation in modern Belarusian society were analyzed; the study of intergenerational communication in the Republic of Belarus was conducted.
