Object of study: media gender stereotypes.

Subject of study: different images of female doctors in social media.

The purpose of the study: to reveal how the stereotypical media images on female doctors are created and spread in Chinese society.

Research methods: case analysis, data analysis, content analysis, survey.

The obtained results: The different images of female PhDs in media were examined and role of media stereotypes was released; the young viewers' perceptions of media stereotypes were examined.

The novelty of the obtained results: Based on the results of the survey it has been shown that presentation of negative media stereotypes of Chinese female doctors still prevails and needs changes to promote gender equality.

Area of possible practical application: Results can be applied to guide media practices, promote gender equality advocacy, and inform policymakers on how to improve the image of female PhDs in the media.
