## ANNOTATION

The master's thesis of the graduate student of the Department of Social Communication of the Faculty of Philosophy and Social Sciences of BSU Yang Sijin "The Role of Social Communications in the Network Society" is devoted to the study of the specifics of the network society and the analysis of the role of social communications in the space of social networks.

The first chapter reveals and describes the main characteristics of modern society as a network society and substantiates the increasing importance of social networks in the sphere of social communications. The second chapter is devoted to revealing the reasons and factors that determine the development and transformation of social communications in the digital age. Statistical data on the circulation and use of specific social networks in China and Belarus are used as the empirical basis of the study. The third chapter is devoted to analyzing the concept of network society by M. Castells and identifying the peculiarities of social communications in the digital age. The peculiarities of social networks development in China and Belarus are given as an example. The emphasis is placed on identifying the positive and negative consequences of using social networks, and the perspective of the development of social communications in the network society is analyzed.
